

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM - CALL FOR PROPOSALS - SPRING 2017

Florence University of the Arts (FUA) is a multidisciplinary institution that seeks to offer dynamic possibilities of study through a rich selection of academic institutions and departments.

Our vision:

- FUA unites communities, nationalities, compelling projects, and studies capable of shaping the cultural landscape of Florence.
- FUA encourages students to be challenged by both classroom and service learning for civic engagement, and to challenge the weight of Florence's glorious heritage in order to contribute to its future with a fresh mind and open eyes.
- FUA strives to provide its students with an experience that goes beyond the Renaissance façade of Florence by communicating to them that who we are and what they experience go beyond cultural stereotypes.
- FUA believes that each student should go back home with a clear concept of Florence and Italy that includes a profound cultural understanding gained from integration. What they receive from the experience is a life changed and newfound understanding and perspectives that they will carry in their hearts for the rest of their lives.

To be effective, this vision requires actions that permit integration not only among students but also international instructors, giving them the opportunity to participate within FUA Departments in order to make a positive contribution to FUA's international objectives. Direct interaction will not only foster the internationalization of FUA faculty but also an intellectual enrichment for the faculty coming from abroad thanks to the exchange of ideas and experiences.

For these purposes, FUA is launching a call for proposals in the area of its Faculty Development Program, to select suitable projects aimed at the development of an integration-based teaching and learning environment for the progress of innovative pedagogic methodologies.

All the integrated experiences related to the Faculty Development Program will:

- Take place within FUA SPRING 2017 Intersession Week III/Seminars, March 20-24, 2017.
- Allow for faculty from abroad to teach 1-day FUA seminars during the week.
- Account for interaction between faculty coming from abroad and FUA departments.

Seminars at FUA are conceived as events/intensive workshops that are mostly geared towards educational topics and usually feature one or more experts on the subject matter. They are existing courses listed with course descriptions in the FUA Academic Catalog. Subject matter is pre-defined by the course title and description. Participants must refer to the catalog content in developing the seminar content, and at the same time enhance the content with expertise and perspectives from their personal professional backgrounds. Participants engage in the discussion of an academic subject, which often includes hands-on activities, for the aim of gaining a better insight into the subject.

Usually seminars are attended by students coming from the FUA Career programs but they are open to every student of FUA's academic divisions that are interested in the seminar topics. Seminars are

also open to the general public. Participation in seminars for all students represents an opportunity given as an additional education that will enrich their stay in Florence and will permit to them to meet new disciplines and gain a broader vision.

The sessions are headed or led by a seminar instructor who serves to steer the discussion and activities along the desired path. The result is to provide the students with insights and broader reflections on the issues of the core courses they are already taking in Florence. All the seminars are taught in English. Seminar teaching may be co-hosted by an FUA faculty counterpart.

In terms of FUA Career Program students attending seminars, this particular student population is made up of 1 to 2-year students attending targeted programs with a predetermined course track. Seminars are often chosen by career students as an additional supplement to regular coursework. For a complete knowledge of the Career Programs offered at FUA see:

Please note that seminars will be activated with the enrollment of at least 5 students.

Teaching seminars: FUA educational policy

The quality of education is the first issue of priority pursued by FUA. It depends largely on the qualifications and competencies of the faculty. In view of the faculty's vital role in influencing education outcomes, FUA launched a Faculty Development Program (FDP) specifically addressed to the faculty of any of the FUA affiliated universities listed at the following address at FUA's website: http://fua.it/The-Institution/the-institution.html#affiliations

Applicants may have any type of contract at their home institutions but have at least a master's degree or be appointed as Professors of Practice.

The goal in terms of FUA faculty is to allow for FUA instructors to enter into contact with international colleagues and exchange best practices both in the field of innovative pedagogical ideas and in the field of innovative didactics.

The international presenter/s, will meet the targeted FUA department staff members to review the seminar before the start date.

The experience that FUA presents is based on the capacity to integrate to its SPRING 2017 seminars competencies and ideas of the international faculty and FUA faculty in a process of a specific, innovative, and qualitative growth of teaching alimented by mixed/collaborative contributions.

Selected instructors will stay for approximately a week in Florence. The presence of the international instructor at FUA should start at least a few days prior to the start of the selected seminars in order for the candidate to be exposed to FUA faculty and academic team through planned meetings to discussed projects, methodologies, and teaching tools.

Call for proposals

Interested international faculty is asked to choose one or more seminars according to her/his/their competencies and current research/projects among the following SPRING 2017 Seminars as listed below:

Proposal:

Each international faculty can present one or more projects related to one or a maximum of four seminars.

Deadline:

Proposals must be attached to the Application Form (see Appendix 1) and sent to FUA's Department of Research, <u>research@fua.it</u>, no later than September 30, 2016.

Selection:

FUA's Academic Senate will select the applications and communicate the elected project by October 10, 2016. Proposals will be evaluated for criteria related to innovation and content that aims to offer new perspectives from the international community as a further enhancement to the educational paths currently being taken by FUA students.

Number of winners:

FUA will select a maximum of 5 projects for 5 different seminars.

Seminar Activation:

Seminars appointed to the winners faculty will run in March 2017 if a minimum of 5 student are enrolled.

Commitment:

Within 1 month of seminar conclusion, appointed international faculty will submit a research monograph of approx. 30 pages to describe educational path proposed and gained from the seminar.

Release Form:

Selected candidates must also submit a photo of themselves and a release form to authorize the publication of news related to the seminar and/or seminar results.

Who may apply:

All faculty of FUA-affiliated universities with:

- PhD qualifications
- MA/MS/Mphil/Equivalent qualifications
- Professor of Practice qualification

FUA will provide the following to selected instructors:

- 1. Travel expenses (roundtrip flight)
- 2. Accommodation expenses for 7 days in Florence
- 3. Participation in Department meetings/sessions and in the Seminar.
